

- Share situation/damage assessment information and Resource Requsts with adjacent counties; and
- Forward the County Summary to the Exercise Controller.

#### **Objectives/Command Emphasis:**

1. **SAFETY** is priority #1: Protect LIFE, PROPERTY AND EQUIPMENT, and the ENVIRONMENT.

- 2. Test ability to:
  - 2a. Activate Unit / Mobilize resources / Establish Radio Nets,
  - 2b.Conduct county-wide situation and damage assessment activities,
  - 2c.Contact Adjacent Counties via

HF (40M SSB ) or VHF (2M FM) voice, and

HF or VHF WinLink RMS Express using standard WinLink ICS forms; and

• 2d.(Marion County only) Establish an AREDN MESH Network in Marion County, and use it to

send and receive WinLink RMS Express messages,

conduct chat sessions,

post documents to a file server, and

- use VOIP telephones
- 2e. Deactivate Unit, Conduct After-Action Review, and Submit Documentation
